The New England Market is the second in a series of local markets planned for 2015 curated and created by Remodelista, and will be held at Lekker Home in Boston's South End. The Remodelista New England Market, which features small artisan makers and designers from throughout *the region*, will focus on goods for the home along with clothing, jewelry, organic botanicals, artisanal foods, and more. The Remodelista San Francisco Market drew over 4,000 attendees during the one-day event last December.

Remodelista markets have been noted for bringing little-known favorites of the design site to a broader audience, who enjoy the feel of "organic collaboration" at the two-day events. "This is our sixth year of holding these markets and the first in Boston, and we're noticing how they generate a truly collaborative spirit between the retailers as well as a sense of energy with shoppers," said Remodelista editor-in-chief, Julie Carlson. "New England has an amazingly creative collection of makers, and we're pleased to have put together a great mix of goods. While the emphasis will be on wares for the home, we'll also be featuring lifestyle goods as well."

Given the enthusiastic local following for Remodelista.com and the sophisticated consumer base, Boston was a natural next step in the growth of the Remodelista Local Markets. "We've been following Lekker Home for years and have long been fans of their modern mix" said Carlson. "They were the obvious choice to host our first market here."

"Hosting these markets is a way to directly introduce Remodelista's readers to artisans who might otherwise have trouble reaching a larger market." Said Natalie van Dijk, Founder of Lekker Home, "We're thrilled to be involved in an event that puts a Boston spin on the Remodelista aesthetic and combines their refined design inspiration with our favorite local talents." "The Remodelista ethos and aesthetic strongly resonates with our readers, who are passionate about the site and see us as a community of like-minded thinkers," said Carlson. "These markets feel like an antidote to the world of online commerce: we all crave human interaction, and the knowledge of the stories behind what we consume, the provenance of a purchase, is important to people."

There will also be gourmet foodstuffs, and local distilleries are sharing tastes of their latest concoctions. And finally, Carlson will be on hand to meet local Remodelista readers and sign copies of her book, "*Remodelista: A Manual for the Considered Home*."
