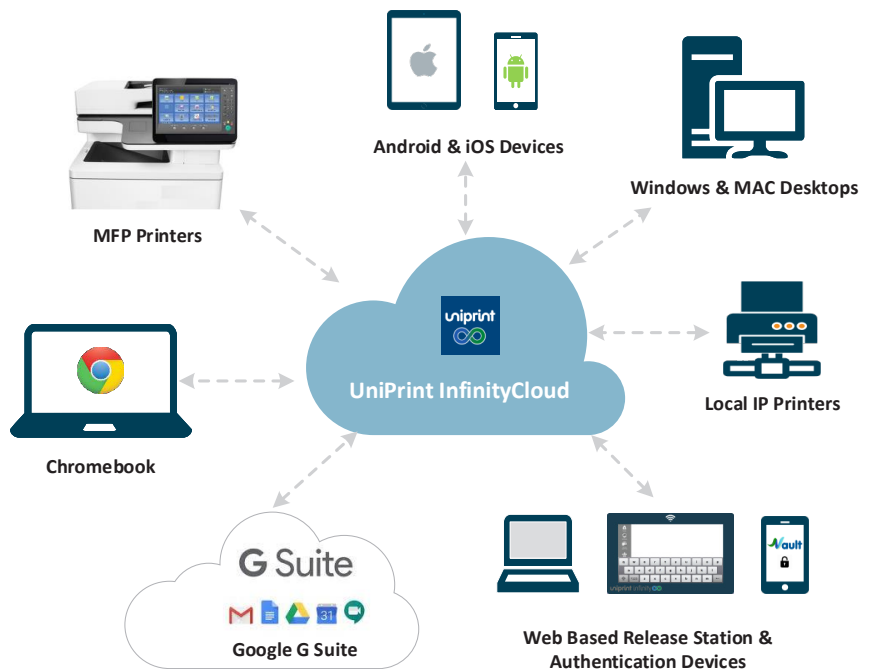

How It Works

All printers and their printer data are migrated from your print servers to the Cloud. After a user downloads and installs the UniPrint Cloud agent onto their workstations, it will automatically retrieve all the appropriate printer drivers for their IP printers from the InfinityCloud platform. The user then simply needs to select PRINT and the print job will be sent directly to the IP printer.

Print jobs can also be sent to the Cloud to be released on demand through any mobile device or secure release station.
