Polling Finds Tight Race in LA County Sheriff Race

Tulchin Research conducted a recent survey of 800 likely November 2022 voters in Los Angeles County on the Sheriff's race that finds a very tight contest. Specifically, our polling finds Sheriff Alex Villanueva in a dead heat with challenger Robert Luna. We highlight these findings below.

Sheriff Villanueva in Tight Race with Challenger Robert Luna

In the general election horserace for County Sheriff, Sheriff Villanueva is currently locked in a very close race. The incumbent attracts 4-in-10 votes (40%), the EXACT amount that Luna receives (40%) while one-in-five voters (20%) remain undecided in the race.

In sum, this poll should make it clear to the interested parties following the race along with the public that the race for LA County Sheriff remains a very close contest with just weeks remaining in the election.

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Survey Methodology: *Tulchin Research conducted a survey among 800 likely November 2022 general election voters in Los Angeles County. Interviews were conducted with live professional callers dialing landlines and cell phones and included responses online via e-mail and text message. The survey was conducted in English and Spanish August 24-30, 2022. The overall margin of error for this survey is +/- 3 percent.*
